These methods were designed to encourage active participation, with group activities and role plays fostering teamwork and empathy, while audio-visual clips provided dynamic and illustrative learning moments. Storytelling was also a vital component, helping to convey complex concepts through relatable narratives, allowing participants to connect emotionally and cognitively with the material. This diverse methodology supported an inclusive, interactive, and impactful learning experience.
